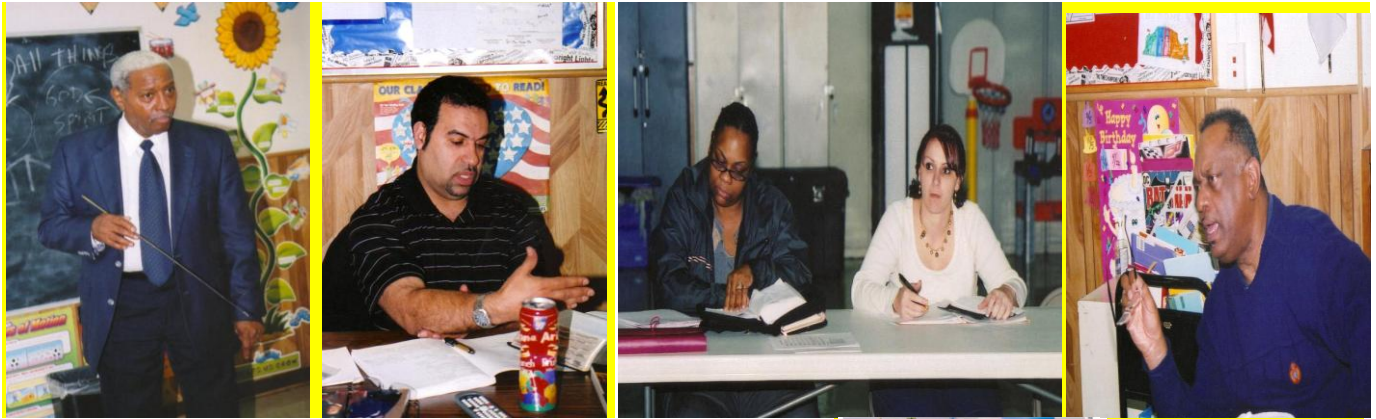
** Definitions:

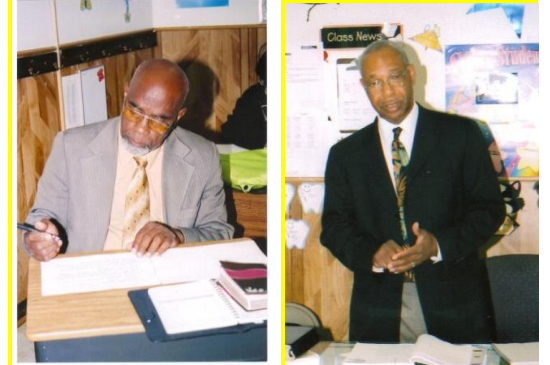

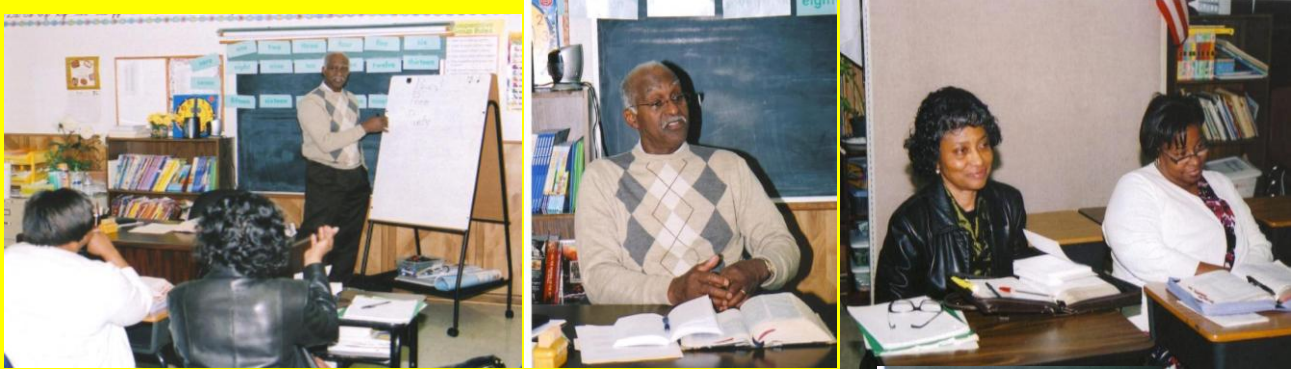
